The Pope's Intention for February

Comfort for the afflicted: That all those who are afflicted, especially the poor, refugees and marginalised, may find welcome and comfort in our communities.

February 6th Feast Day

St. Paul Miki was the son of a Japanese military leader. He became a Jesuit in 1859 and was known for his eloquent preaching. He and 25 other Catholics were crucified on February 5th during the persecution of Christians in the name of the Japanese Emperor. They were all canonised as the Martyrs of Japan in 1862.

February 10th Feast Day

St Scholastica was the sister of St. Benedict. She founded a Benedictine convent a few miles away from the famous monastery set up by her brother. They used to meet once a year for spiritual conversation. She is the patron saint of nuns and is invoked against storms and rain.
